Dear Parent/Guardian

The Immunisation Team CWPT are providing a restoration schedule to allow all children requiring their HPV2 vaccine to be vaccinated at one of our clinics. Unfortunately, due to the Covid pandemic and our current restoration schedule we do not have the capacity to offer this in school. It is important to utilise these clinics to get your child(ren) protected as per current Public Health England Guidelines.

These clinics will run at Jepson House, Manor Hospital Site, Manor Court Avenue in Nuneaton. If your child is still outstanding their 2nd HPV vaccination with at least **6-month** time lapse since their first vaccination. (First dose will have been given in school in September 2020). Please book your child(s) **HPV** vaccination using the following link for Swiftqueue.

If you wish to book your child into a vaccination clinic, please click on the link above to access the online booking system (Swiftqueue). You will be required to register before continuing with the booking. **You will need to register your child's details, not your own.** Swiftqueue will only allow an email address to be used by one account holder, therefore if you already have a Swiftqueue account or have more than one child, you will be able to add family members to an existing account. Please note the Swiftqueue booking system shows more available clinics if you access it on either a laptop or a tablet as the bigger the screen the more clinics that show.

Clinics are available on: 13th, 17th, 22nd, 23rd, 26th and 27th July 2021

1. A responsible adult should bring child to clinic if possible.
2. The responsible adult will be required to wait for the child in their car or a designated outside space.
3. Responsible adults will not be allowed in under any circumstances.
4. The child needs to wear a face covering to cover their mouth and nose this could be a scarf or fabric mask.
5. The immunisation clinics are fully risk assessed and processes and procedures have been adapted to minimise infection risk and ensure maximum protection for the children, responsible adults and the immunisation team always.
