## New Year Science Spectacular

On Thursday 12th January the Science department put on a New Year Science Spectacular for the whole of Year 7

The theme for the show was.. "How do we help Virgin launch their rocket successfully?"



We gave the Year 7s a bit of background to the rocket launch and then discussed combustion

We showed a combustion reaction with custard powder, where the lid of the custard pot was blown off!



Ethanol was poured and shaken around an empty water bottle. Once removed, the vapours were lit to produce a rocket powered flame!

Each time something was blown up, burnt or exploded, we asked "what is happening?" The chorus of "it's a combustion reaction" was fantastic and the pupils were able to identify that a fuel AND oxygen were needed for the reaction to take place. Well done Year 7!

Our finale was the screaming jelly baby! When 'Nigel' and 'Dazza' were placed in potassium chlorate, they exploded and 'screamed' and produced LOTS of smoke! Year 7 seemed to love this one!
