




THE FORGETTING CURVE

Monday 27/11/17 un(e) chanteur = a singer. Un groupe de rock = a rock group. Le rythme = the rhythm. Il joue de la batterie = he plays the drums. Il joue de la guitare = he plays the guitar. Le meilleur = the best. Le concert = concert. Le festival de musique = music festival. Gratuit = free.

Tuesday 28/11/17 Global warming = the air around the earth getting warmer. Lianas = thick vines that loop around the trees. Shrub layer = Geophytes that grow close to the ground. Emergent = the tallest trees in the rainforest. Canopy = thickest tree layer where most animals live. Under canopy = younger, shorter, trees and bushes. Deforestation = cutting down trees.

Wednesday Pesach = the passover celebrates the israelites liberation from slavery in egypt, led by moses. The torah = the five books of moses. Tabernacle = the tent built as the dwelling place of god's presence among the israelites. Sacrifice = giving something precious back to god through rightful death.

Thursday 30/11/17 Climate = what the weather is usually like in a place, in any given month. Weather = the state of atmosphere at any given time. Clouds = condensed water vapour which turns into millions of tiny water droplets. Dew = tiny drops of water that form on cool surfaces. Fog = at night when the atmospheric vapor condenses fog a thick cloud of water droplets suspended.

Friday 1/12/17 Scapegoat = a perfect goat sent into the wilderness on yom kippur, to carry away the sins of people. Atonement = a sacrifice which pays the penalty for sin, returning humans back to the right relationship with god and the world. The sacrifice to you. Sacrifice = giving something precious to god. The torah = the five books of moses.

20/12/17 Act of Supremacy - A law passed by parliament which led to 9/11/18 History the creation of the Church of England. Martyr - a person who dies for their (religious) beliefs. Book of Common Prayer - After terms book of prayers written in English used in the church of England.

Martyr, Catholicism - A major branch of Christianity led from Rome by the pope. Propaganda - information made to make people think a certain way.






Flashcards

You put the first letter of each word on your second card and then test yourself – can you remember the sentence of the definition perfectly?


One side is a summary of a topic
Side 2 is 3-4 questions about that topic







